JULIE MCGUIRE CO-AUTHORS 2008 UPDATE TO *DOING BUSINESS IN NORTH AMERICA*

McGuire, a founder of Pittsburgh-based law firm Hull McGuire PC, has authored the Pennsylvania chapter of *Legal Aspects of Doing Business in North America*. Firms that authored chapters include Clifford Chance (New York chapter), Baker & McKenzie (Texas) and Barnes & Thornburg (Indiana).

Doing Business is written for non-North American companies and their lawyers. It provides a comprehensive overview of U.S. and Canadian federal laws, with specific chapters devoted to American states and Canadian provinces and territories. Topics include choice of entity, tax laws, acquisition of real estate, arbitrations, employer-employee relations, and protection of intellectual property.

First published in 1988, *Doing Business* is a product of Yorkhill Law Publishing, an arm of the Center for International Legal Studies (CILS), based in Salzburg, Austria. The 3-volume, 1400-page updated series became available for purchase from Yorkhill in late 2008.
